Faculty of Allied Health Sciences Holds Orientation for PG students ...Introduces Researchers' Week

The Faculty of Allied Health Sciences has conducted an orientation program for all Post Graduate students with the Dean Dr. Bashir Kaka charging them to be of good character..

Speaking at the orientation which held at the twin theatre in the College of Health Sciences on Saturday, 12th February, 2022, he said the University had certain rules and regulations that are mandatory for every student to strictly abide.

Dr. Kaka noted that degree is being awarded based on certification of one's character and learning therefore if any one of these is missing a student will not be eligible to get the degree.

He said they should consider themselves lucky as they were admitted based on merit and not on any sentiment.

The Dean advised all students to work hard and engage with their supervisors regularly so as to graduate on time.

Dr. Kaka stated that students who don't concentrate are blocking the chances of others, wasting their resources and the lecturers' time.

He further informed students that there would be a program called 'research day' where students will be given opportunity to come and showcase their research.

The Dean concluded by encouraging the students to follow the university's rules throughout their stay.

Earlier, the faculty Coordinator, Dr. Isa Usman Lawal in his welcome address, congratulated the newly admitted students for being part of Bayero University family.

The PG coordinators from the Department of Nursing Sciences, Dr. Ahmad Rufai Abubakar and his counterparts from Radiography, Dr. Musa Dambele, gave brief lectures on professional postgraduate program.

He started by listing all the PGD/Professional Masters programs in the faculty and explained how the programs were done from admission to graduation.

The PG Coordinator of the Department of Radiography, Dr. Musa Dambele also gave a lecture on Academic Masters. He said that the program was supposed to instill some discipline in the students. He talked about what the program is all about taking them through the admission and registration process, course work and research to external defense.

He also cautioned the students to be very careful with course codes during registration and stressed on the importance of registering on time.

Dr. Dambele informed the students that any issue that arose during the course of study should be addressed officially and on time.

Also, the PG Coordinator of the Department of Physiotherapy, Dr. Umar Badaru talked about the Mphil/PHD program. He started by saying that the Postgraduate regulation cut across all the PG programs and it was important to be guided by the handbook.

He gave a brief introduction of the Mphil/PHD program and explained the difference between the two programs.

Another speaker, Dr. Hassan Yahaya, the PG Coordinator of the Department of Medical Laboratory Sciences talked on Dissertation/Thesis writing to the students. He took them through research from writing of synopsis to external defense.

Dr. Isa Usman Lawal further elaborated on all the topics and thanked everyone for honoring the invitation.

Highlight of the event was a question and answer session in which students freely engaged the lecturers to get more explanations on certain issues and were all answered.
