Their commitment and vision played pivotal role in laying the foundation for these institutions.

We believed that investing in science and technology education was essential to equip our youth with the skills and knowledge necessary to drive Kano and Nigeria toward a more prosperous future. Today, these schools stand as a testament to what can be achieved when we prioritize education and invest in the younger generation.

Ongoing Commitment to Education

This recognition today is not just a celebration of our contributions but also a testament to the collective efforts of many individuals who shared our vision. It is a reminder of what can be accomplished when we work together for a greater cause.

In more recent years, my dedication to education has remained steadfast. Through the **Sani Bello Foundation**, we are pleased to announce a donation of **100,000,000 Naira** (**One Hundred Million Naira**) to support Research and Development in Science, and Technology. This contribution reflects my strong belief in the transformative power of innovation and our desire to see Nigerian institutions—particularly Bayero University Kano—lead the charge in solving real-world challenges through research and technology.
